ARUN PALLI J. (Oral)

On December 4, 2015, this court had passed the following order:

“Contends, inter alia, that vide order being assailed, dated 19.10.2015, the appellate authority has assessed mesne profits and the tenant-respondent was directed to deposit the arrears within a period of two months from the date of the order. It is contended that the appeal is listed for final arguments on 10.12.2015 and the afore-indicated period of two months shall expire on 19.12.2015, and till date the tenant has not deposited the mesne profits, but continues to enjoy the possession because of the stay granted by the appellate authority.

Notice of motion for 08.12.2015.

Process dasti as well, with a liberty to serve the respondents through their counsel before the appellate authority.

To be shown in the urgent list.”

Mr. Aman Bahri, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of the respondents and submits that the entire arrears of mesne profits, payable from the date of order of eviction, shall be deposited by the tenants-respondents by tomorrow i.e. 09.12.2015. However, he submits that the appellate authority be directed to decide the appeal within a specified time. Something, that satisfies the counsel for the petitioners.

That being so, and in the wake of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the revision petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. The appellate authority is directed to decide the appeal on the date already fixed i.e. 10.12.2015, if possible, and, in any case, within two weeks thereafter.
