Challenge in this appeal is to the judgment dated 18.12.2003, passed by Sh. Ashok Kumar, Additional Sessions Judge, Fast-track Court, Ferozepur, vide which the accused-appellant, namely, Rajinder and Hardev Singh have been convicted under Sections 325, 323, 452 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (hereinafter reads as 'IPC').

Sukhdev Singh-injured is present in the Court. The injured-Sukhdev Singh and learned counsel for both the injured i.e. Sukhdev Singh and Balwinder Kaur, have stated at the bar that the matter can be compromised and have further stated at the bar that

they are neighbourers and they are ready to compromise the matter with the appellant on payment of Rs.1,50,000/- as compensation. Learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions from the appellant, has accepted the said offer.

As per Custody Certificate, the accused-appellants, namely, Rajinder and Hardev Singh, have undergone incarceration for a period of 02 months and 21 days, out of the substantive sentence of 03 years.

Since, the matter has been amicably settled, so in these circumstances the sentence of both the appellants stands reduced to the period already undergone by them. However, the appellants shall pay a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- to both the injured. The said amount shall be paid within six months from today, out of which Rs.50,000/- through draft shall be paid to the claimant-injured within 15 days in the trial Court and the remaining amount shall be paid on or before six months from today, failing which the appeal of the appellant would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Appeal stands disposed of, accordingly.
