1. There is no clarity in the petition to explain as to how the decree obtained by Sewa Singh against Ishar Kaur will have any relevance and how the said decree obtained in the year 1992 could be set aside now. Without any adequate pleading inclusion of some new relief by virtue of some contentions made by the defendant is impermissible. The civil revision is dismissed and I affirm the decision of the lower court for the lack of clarity on the submissions as well as pleadings made by the plaintiff. If the petitioner seeks for has any relief in relation to the property that is relevant, he may come with an independent suit or may disclose about particulars of the relevance in the present suit.

2. Civil revision is dismissed but with the observations made above.
