Challenge in the present writ petition is for quashing of impugned order dated 03.02.1989, whereby the petitioner was reverted as Work Division Supervisor in the Narnaul in the pay scale of ₹950-1400/-.

The petitioner is stated to have filed representation against the aforementioned impugned order which was not decided and ultimately approached this Court vide CWP No.5370 of 1992 for quashing of the order Annexure P-4.

The State has filed reply. Copy of the order stated to have been passed in pursuance to the compliance of the direction contained in the aforementioned order is annexed as Annexure R-1 with the reply.

The petitioner has not challenged the aforementioned order. During the pendency of the present writ petition, the factum of deciding the representation & passing of order, thereon, was in the knowledge of the petitioner. It has been stated in the order dated 24.08.1993 (Annexure R-1) that one Hoshiar Singh who was junior to the petitioner filed the writ petition against the order of reversion but the same had not been decided finally. Till date no action has been taken to challenge the same.

The claim of the petitioner in the present writ petition is based on the tentative seniority list which has ultimately been finalized by promulgation of the final seniority list.

Thus, in essence, the petitioner was/is required to challenge the final seniority list along with order of reversion but no action has been taken therefore, no cause of action survives in the present writ petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
