AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner is claiming higher pay scale meant for technical posts.

The admitted facts are that the petitioner was appointed as Waiter in the Haryana Tourism Corporation Limited-respondent. By letter dated 23.08.1990 the Haryana Government revised the pay scales of technical posts and by document Annexure P-8 dated 26.07.1991 it was further clarified that those persons who were working on technical posts and have the qualification mentioned therein would be given the pay scales as detailed there. The contention of the petitioner is that he is a Matriculate and had a diploma from a Catering Institute at Panipat and, therefore, he is entitled to get the higher pay scale. I put it to learned counsel whether the post of Waiter is a technical post and whether it has been ever included as a

technical post either in schedule or notification; to both the questions I have drawn a blank. Learned counsel for the petitioner is neither in a position to explain how the post of Waiter is a technical post nor has he been able to point out any notification or list whereby the Government may have considered the post of Waiter to be a technical post.

No other point has been urged.

In the circumstances the petition is dismissed.
