RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

[1]. The present revision petition is having glaring facts. Hans Raj retired on 30.11.1994. His retiral dues were not paid. For the claim of his retiral dues, he filed a civil suit for mandatory injunction before the trial Court. Suit was decreed in his favour by the trial Court on 14.06.2001.

[2]. Petitioner/Council remained unsuccessful in First Appeal before the lower Appellate Court. Regular Second Appeal filed by the petitioner/Council was dismissed on 27.01.2005 by this Court and the petitioner/Council also

remained unsuccessful before the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the SLP which was dismissed on 04.08.2006.

[3]. Retiree Hans Raj had already died. His legal representatives filed execution for recovery of retiral dues of Hans Raj on 16.08.2014 which was objected by the petitioner/Council. On 18.11.2015, executing Court allowed the execution and asked the decree-holders to provide list of properties of the judgment-debtor for the purposes of issuing warrant of attachment on or before 30.11.2015.

[4]. The needful has already been done on 30.11.2015. Warrants of attachment have already been issued. The proceedings of the executing Court have been assailed in the present revision petition.

[5]. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the only dispute is with regard to interest and every endeavour would be made to pay the same within a period of two months from today. He seeks to withdraw this revision petition.

[6] Dismissed as withdrawn.
