ARUN PALLI J. (Oral)

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition, as he does not wish to pursue the same any further. However, he submits that the time to deposit the arrears of mesne profits, pursuant to the order being assailed, dated 05.12.2015, was till 09.12.2015 and, thus, petitioner be only granted three weeks' further time to deposit the entire arrears.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, time to deposit the arrears of mesne profits, as ordered by the appellate authority, is extended by three weeks from today i.e. upto 31.12.2015.
