The petition for injunction had been ordered to the plaintiff and for an alleged disobedience of the order, he moved a petition under Order 39 Rule 2A CPC. The District Judge has marked the case to another Judge and the petition was filed for transfer of petition under Order 39 Rule 2A CPC to the very same Court which issued the order of injunction. The Court has declined the transfer.

I set aside the order as not tenable and direct the Order 39 Rule 2A CPC petition to be posed before the very same Court which originally issued the order of injunction, irrespective of the fact whether all the parties are the same or not.

The civil revision petition is ordered on above terms.
