Harkanwaljeet Singh who is reported to be the son of respondent Ravinder Kaur, stated that his mother died last year and is present in person. He states that the petitioner-tenant has surrendered the possession of the property to him as a legal representative of the deceased landlord.

Counsel for the petitioner also admits that he has surrendered the possession of the property. It is stated that there is yet another case CR No. 1109 of 2004 between the same parties. The person present before this Court also states that the said case will be withdrawn in the light of the subsequent event of the tenant surrendering the possession of the property. The statement is recorded and the instant petition is disposed of as having become unnecessary for adjudication.
