There is no requirement to approach this Court when evidence is closed. This Court has in judgment CR No. 5639 of 2012, Santosh Kumar Berry Vs. Nirmala Devi and others decided on 25.09.2012, detailed the procedure to be followed where the plaintiff side is closed. The Court will have adequate power to recall its order and reopen the evidence close in sufficient circumstances where justified reasons are given for his inability to produce the evidence on the day when it was posted.

The civil revisin petition is disposed of and the Court will have to follow the procedure as already laid down by this Court in the aforesaid judgment.
