AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

On the basis of the statement made by counsel for the petitioner on 13.08.2015, notice of motion was issued to limited extent of affording some reasonable time to vacate the premises.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would vacate the premises within a period of four months from today.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed on merits. However, as per the statement made by counsel for the petitioner, four months' time is granted to the petitioner to vacate the premises subject to his furnishing an undertaking in this Court within a period of two weeks from today that he shall hand over the vacant possession of the demised premises to the respondents on or before 18th December, 2015 and that he shall pay the mesne profit at the rate as assessed by this Court on or before 7th day of the month. This would be further subject to deposit of arrears of rent till date alongwith the undertaking. The mesne profits for these four months' would be at the rate of ₹3,000/- per month.
