KULDIP SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Impugned in the present revision petition is order dated 09.09.2014, passed by learned Additional District Judge (Adhoc), Fast Track Court, Hoshiarpur, vide which the order dated 05.02.2014, passed by learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, Mukerian was set aside, wherein the parties were directed to maintain status quo regarding the passage in question.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have also carefully gone through the file.

It comes out that plaintiff had sought the injunction for restraining the defendants from obstructing her from use of the

passage leading to her house from the property, bearing Khasra No.287/2/2, situated at Village Beh Nangal, Tehsil Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

It comes out that disputed property is in possession of DAV High School having been allotted by Gram Panchayat. In the disputed property a co-educational school is functioning. Plaintiff claims passage through the said school. The Appellate Court has observed that the Aks Shajra as well as in the jamabandi taken on record shows that Khasra No. 287/2/4 belongs to Gram Panchayat and other and there is no passage in existence in the Aks Shajra as claimed by the claimant. Plaintiff has got no right to claim passage through the school so as to compromise its security. It is always open to the plaintiff to get entrance to her house from some other source.

It being so, there is no ground to interfere in the impugned order passed by the learned Additional District Judge (Adhoc), Fast Track Court, Hoshiarpur.

Consequently, the present revision stands dismissed.
