1. There is no justification for the plaintiff to arrive before this court to complain that the evidence has been closed. It shall be open for the party to apply to the very same court setting out the reasons for the absence on that day and seek for reopening the side and allowing for witnesses to be examined. The procedure has been laid down by this court in **Santosh Kumar Berry Versus Nirmala Devi and others-2013(1) PLR 404** and the petitioner will move such an application and adopt such a procedure as laid down in the said judgment.
