Both the parties agree that the Appellate Court before which the appeal is pending against the order of summary ejectment will also consider the issue of whether the petitioner will be entitled to stay of dispossession or not. The case is reported to be posted for 05.05.2015 and the counsel for the tenant says that all the directions given by this Court on 12.02.2015 as regards the payments of arrears of rent have been complied with.

The civil revision petition is disposed of as requiring no further adjudication, but till the Appellate Court decides on the issue that whether the petitioner will have the benefit of possession or not his possession will be protected. The petitioner shall furnish the details of deposits alleged to have been made pursuant to the directions of this Court to the respondent.
