Present appeal has been preferred by appellant Kaushal Kumar alias Rajesh impugning his conviction for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366 and 376, IPC and consequent sentence of rigorous imprisonment of seven years, besides, a fine of ₹2000/- vide impugned judgment and order dated 16.02.2010 and 22.02.2010 respectively passed by Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal.

Learned counsel for the State has filed an affidavit dated 30.07.2015 of Ashok Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Karnal. It reflects that the appellant has already undergone period of sentence imposed upon him by the learned trial court. Appellant was finally released on 05.09.2014 at jail gate. Fine stands paid.

It appears that due to this reason itself none has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant today as well as on the last occasion when the appeal came up for hearing. In view of the fact revealed above in the affidavit dated 30.07.2015, present appeal has been rendered infructuous.
