This appeal was filed by the prosecutrix for challenging the judgment dated 12.11.2013 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fazilka whereby respondent No.2-Jaswant Singh was acquitted of the charges under Sections 376 and 420 IPC.

Respondent No.2-Jaswant Singh was acquitted for the aforementioned offences. However, the trial Court while acquitting respondent No.2 for the aforesaid offences, convicted him under Section 417 IPC and sentenced him to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year and to pay a fine of Rs.5000/-.

Pursuant to the order dated 21.01.2015, passed by the coordinate Bench of this Court, the appellant along with her minor daughter appeared before this Court on 03.03.2015. However, respondent No.2 failed to put in appearance as he was reported to be unwell. On the adjourned date,

the appellant as well as respondent No.2 appeared in person and respondent No.2 stated that he was ready and willing to amicably settle the matter with the appellant. In view of the same, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Vide report dated 07.07.2015, the Director, Mediation and Conciliation Centre, has informed the Court that the parties have settled the matter amicably. The terms of the settlement recorded between the parties have also been placed on the file.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that since the matter has been amicably resolved, the appellant may be permitted to withdraw the appeal.

The appeal is hereby, dismissed as withdrawn.
