The present appeal against the conviction has been filed by Parveen Kumar son of Satpal, Proprietor M/s Paul Vijay Kumar, New Grain Market, Kapurthala.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the appellant had stated that as per his information, appellant-Parveen Kumar has already died.

Learned State counsel was asked to verify the factum regarding the death of appellant-Parveen Kumar.

Learned State counsel has filed the report by way of affidavit of Mr. Daljit Singh Dhillon, DSP, Sub Division, District Kapurthala which shows that appellant-Parveen Kumar has died on 9.1.2011. His affidavit is also accompanied with the death certificate of Parveen Kumar as well as the copies of statements of Seema

Rani widow of Parveen Kumar and Rajinder Singh, Municipal Councillor, Mohalla Kaimpura, Ward No.12, P.S. City Kapurthala.

As per the aforesaid report and the documents, appellant-Parveen Kumar has already died on 9.1.2011. No application has been moved by his legal representatives to pursue the present appeal within the stipulated period.

So, the present appeal hereby abates as per the provisions of Section 394 Cr.P.C and is disposed of being abated.
