Learned State counsel produced on record common statement of Jaipal Singh, Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat village Chanarthal Kalan, District Fatehgarh Sahib and others dated 16.10.2015 along with photocopy of death certificate of appellant Kartar Singh duly attested by HC Najar Singh, No.454. It is found recorded in said common statement that appellant Kartar Singh son of Gulab Singh was resident of village Chanarthal Kalan, who has since expired on 24.7.2010 on account of protracted illness for a period of about 5-6 years. The factum of death of Kartar Singh is also corroborated by the photocopy of his death certificate. Both the said common statement and photocopy of death certificate are attested by HC Najar Singh above-said. This fact is also inquired from him in the Court and he replied that factum of death of

appellant Kartar Singh as mentioned in the common statement and death certificate are correct. He personally went to village Chanarthal Kalan to verify the fact with regard to the death of appellant Kartar Singh.

This Court is satisfied that appellant Kartar Singh has since been expired, so this appeal stands abated and disposed of accordingly.
