Learned counsel for the State had sought an adjournment on 01.07.2015 to verify whether the appellant has undergone sentence imposed upon him, pursuant to his conviction for the offence punishable under Sections 366, 376 IPC vide judgment and order dated 15.01.2004 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, (Adhoc), Amritsar.
