The appellant, who is grand-father of the prosecutrix and at whose instance, the FIR was registered has filed the present appeal for challenging the acquittal of respondents No.1 and 2 of the charges against them. However, such an appeal could be filed by the victim and not by the complainant even if he happens to be grand-father of the prosecutrix, as admittedly, the prosecutrix is more than 18 years of age as of date.

Faced with the above situation, learned counsel for the appellant submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the appeal.
