MAHESH GROVER, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite his earnest efforts the petitioner has not contacted him. On the previous date i.e. 28.11.2014 time was granted to the learned counsel for the petitioner to ascertain as to whether any cause survives in the petition. Since the petitioner has failed to contact the learned counsel representing him despite opportunities given by this Court and despite efforts made by the learned senior counsel himself, I would deem it appropriate to assume that no cause survives in this petition which would warrant ascertainment by this Court. However, to protect the interest of the petitioner in the eventuality of his having any cause to espouse in the petition, instant petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to make an appropriate application in the eventuality of any surviving cause therein.
