By filing the present appeal, convict-Ravi Kumar @ Kala challenged the judgment and order dated 27/29.7.2010 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, whereby, he was convicted and sentenced as under:-

- (i) Convicted under Section 363 IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.2,000/- and in default of payment of fine to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months.
- (ii) Convicted under Section 366-A IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for seven years and to pay a fine of Rs.3,000/- and in default of payment of fine to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months.
- (iii) Convicted under Section 376 IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for seven years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in default of payment of fine to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year.

All the substantive sentences were ordered to run concurrently. The period of imprisonment already undergone by

him during the course of trial was ordered to be set off against the substantive sentences of imprisonment.

The appeal filed by the convict came to be admitted on 16.9.2010. The application for suspension of sentence made by him was dismissed on 21.11.2013. Subsequently, no application for suspension of sentence of imprisonment was filed.

As per the custody certificate produced by the State counsel, the appellant completed the substantive sentences of imprisonment on 14.1.2015. The amount of fine imposed upon him was, subsequently, deposited on 27.1.2015.

Once the appellant has undergone the entire substantive sentences of imprisonment and also deposited the amount of fine imposed upon him, the present appeal has been rendered infructuous and, the same is, accordingly, disposed of.
