The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned orders of promotion of respondents No. 4 to 16 to the post of Statistical Assistant made by respondent No.3 being ineligible and not having requisite experience.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on the basis of reply and also the seniority list submits that the petitioners and private respondents have retired and the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel and also the fact that petitioners as well as private respondents have retired, which is clear from the seniority list annexed as Annexure P-1, the present petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, in case the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner, they are at liberty to move a representation to the concerned authority.
