This appeal has been filed by Nazim (complainant) against the judgment and order dated 17.12.2013, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat acquitting respondents No. 2 to 10 for the offences punishable under Sections 148, 323, 325 and 307 read with Section 149 IPC. The trial Court was requisitioned by this Court on 11.04.2014 and the case was adjourned to 27.05.2014. On the said date, none appeared for the appellant. In the interest of justice, the case was adjourned to 18.08.2014. It was taken up on 19.08.2014 and on the request of learned counsel for the appellant it was adjourned to 30.10.2014. On 30.10.2014, again on the request of learned counsel for

the appellant, it was adjourned to 20.01.2015. On the said date, none appeared and on written request of learned counsel for the appellant it was adjourned to 27.04.2015. On 27.04.2015, it was submitted by learned counsel appearing for the appellant that Mr. Sudhir Kumar Hooda, Advocate, who was to argue the case was not feeling well. The case was therefore, adjourned to 25.08.2015. On the said date none appeared for the appellant and in the interest of justice, it was adjourned for today i.e. 08.12.2015. Today again no one has appeared on behalf of the appellant.

It seems that the the appellant is not interested to pursue the appeal.

In the circumstances, the appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution.
