DARSHAN SINGH,J

Learned counsel for the appellants stated that both the appellants namely Parveen Kumar and Sohan Lal @ Sohna have died. None of their legal representatives had come forward to pursue the appeal. So, the present appeals have become infructuous.

Learned State counsel has also placed on file the death report of both the appellants made by ASI Darshan Singh, Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar accompanied with the death certificate of Sohan Lal @ Sohna and copy of the FIR's no. 66 dated 30.04.2009, Police Station Radaur, under Section 302/34 of Indian Penal Code and FIR No. 66 dated 23.05.2010, under Section 302 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar.

In the report made by ASI Darshan Singh, it has been mentioned that appellant Sohan Lal @ Sohna has died on 23.05.2010. He was murdered and in that connection with the FIR no. 66 dated 23.05.2010, under Section 302 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act has been registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar. His death certificate has also been issued by the Registrar Birth and Death, District Yamuna Nagar. The aforesaid documents shows that appellant Sohan Lal @ Sohna has died on 23.05.2010. Similarly, the report further shows that appellant Parveen Kumar has also died on 30.04.2009. He was also murdered and in that connection FIR No. 66 dated 30.04.2009, under Section 302/34 of Indian Penal Code has been registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar. Thus, as per the aforesaid reports both the

appellants have died. The legal representatives of none of the appellants has come forward to pursue the appeals.

So, both these appeals stands abetted under Section 394 of Code of Criminal Procedure.
