The appeal has been filed by the complainant-Malkiat Singh against the order dated 25.2.2014 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Barnala whereby respondents No.2 and 3 have been acquitted. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant on the last date of hearing had taken time to show that the appellant is a 'victim' and entitled to file an appeal.

Learned counsel submits that the appellant is not a 'victim' as defined in Section 2 (wa) of the Code of Criminal Procedure so as to file an appeal. He, therefore prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the appeal so as to enable the 'victim' to file an appeal.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
