MAHESH GROVER, J.

The instant petition was filed through Sh. R.P.Bali, Advocate who has since expired. Consequently, when the petition came up for hearing, notice was issued to the petitioners. On 18.3.2015 it was noticed by this Court that notices issued to the petitioners had not been received back served or otherwise and fresh notices were issued. In the meantime, report of the service pursuant to the notices earlier issued by this Court on 8.1.2015 was received indicating service of the petitioners. The fresh notices issued were also received back with the report that petitioners have since retired from service. There is no representation on their behalf despite service.
