Counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the government decision dated 9.8.2010, technical pay scales were granted to all the employees who were working on technical posts, whether they were holding the qualification/s or not, and it is his impression that the petitioners may have also been granted the benefit.

Counsel for the respondents, on the other hand, has argued that subsequent to the aforesaid decision, the State of Haryana has enacted the Act, namely, The Haryana (Abolition of Distinction of Pay Scale Between Technical & Non Technical Posts) Act, 2014 withdrawing the technical pay scales with retrospective effect.

In my opinion, in both the circumstances, the present writ petition cannot survive. If the petitioners have been granted the benefit, this writ petition has been rendered infructuous, and if not, they would have the liberty to challenge the vires of the said Act, if so advised.

Disposed of in the above terms.
