The petition has been pending since 2008. There was no restraint order in proceedings, rather a categoric order was passed by this Court on 10.08.2011 directing the proceedings to be continued in the absence of any restraint order. In view of the fact that proceedings were permitted to continue, I am of the opinion that in all probabilities by now the proceedings would have concluded and if that be so, then the parties to the controversy would have a remedy in law against the order of the trial Court.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner and thus, the latest status of the case is also not available. The petition is, therefore, dismissed. In case the petitioner has any surviving cause, he would be at liberty to apprise the Court in this regard.
