Having heard Mr. Maini, in this matter, it appears from the written defence of the State that there is no life left in this petition and it has become infructuous on account of study leave salary being granted to the petitioners.

A perusal of the prayer and especially a) appears to confirm the arguments of Mr. Maini since petitioners sought a writ of mandamus directing to the respondents to grant study leave salary to the petitioners as paid to other similarly situated staff nurses mentioned in Annexures P-2 to P-4. If this is the position, then nothing subsists to be adjudicated. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach the Court for revival in case any subsisting right exists in them and requires adjudication.

Accordingly the petition stands disposed of.
