In view of the averments mentioned in the application, same is allowed and the main appeal is taken up today itself for final disposal.

RSA No.1495 of 2002 (O&M)

Learned counsel for the respondent has informed that during the pendency of this appeal, the department had initiated departmental proceedings and thereafter, on 22.02.2005, the respondent was reinstated in services. However, subsequently, he was again terminated on 17.03.2005. This order was challenged by the respondent by way of CWP No.20561 of 2008. The said petition was admitted by this Court on 20.07.2009. As far as the present appeal is concerned, the same has been rendered infructuous because the State has already complied with the judgment of the lower appellate Court and had conducted an enquiry against the respondent.

In this view of the matter, the present appeal stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
