The petitioner, who was serving as an Assistant in the office of Director, Development & Panchayat, instituted the present writ petition in the year 1993 seeking directions to the respondents to consider his claim for promotion to the post of Assistant as per roster point earmarked for a Scheduled Caste candidate since he belonged to such category. The writ petition was admitted for final adjudication on 9.11.1993.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that he has no instructions in the matter. Pleadings would indicate that initial appointment of the petitioner was on the post of Clerk in the year 1982.

It appears that on account of efflux of time petitioner is not inclined to pursue the prayer made in the instant writ petition and may have already superannuated.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the petition by filing a requisite application to demonstrate if any cause of action still survives.

Disposed of.
