Learned counsel for the State submits that in view of the nature of controversy involved and also by a afflux of time, cause of action would not survive any further in the writ petition because it was pertaining to the extension of temporary permit and thereafter, period of more than 16 years has elapsed.

Neither anybody is appearing on behalf of petitioners nor any request for pass over has been made. Learned counsel for the State seems to be correct in making above said statement. In this view of the matter present writ petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

However, since nobody is present on behalf of the petitioners, liberty is granted to the petitioners to get the present petition revived, if necessity arises.
