Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to raise all their pleas before the trial court at the time of framing of charge.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. In case the petitioners move an application for exemption of their personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioners on such terms and conditions, as it deems proper to impose. The petitioners may be allowed to appear through their counsel except on the dates when their presence is necessary. Needless to observe that the trial court shall consider all the pleas raised herein at the time of framing of charge. Trial court will endeavour to conclude the proceedings expeditiously.
