Challenge in the present writ petition is to the communication dated 12.6.1997 finding that possession of site measuring 367.52 square yards was given to the petitioners and that the petitioners are liable to pay the rate of interest in terms of the Rules framed under the Capital of Punjab (Development and Regulations) Act, 1952.

In terms of the orders passed by this Court on 17.11.2014, the petitioners were communicated the due amount by the respondents and the petitioners have deposited such amount.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives to the petitioners. Hence, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
