Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all his pleas before the trial court at the time of framing of charge.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. In case the petitioner moves an application for exemption of his personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioner on such terms and conditions, as it deems proper to impose. The petitioner may be allowed to appear through his counsel except on the dates when his presence is necessary. Needless to observe that the trial court shall consider all the pleas raised herein at the time of framing of charge. Trial court will endeavour to conclude the proceedings expeditiously.
