HEMANT GUPTA, J.(Oral)

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present writ petition but seeks indulgence of this Court to grant liberty to deposit the amount determined on an application filed under Rule 11-D of the Chandigarh (Sale of Sites & Building) Rules, 1960, within a period of 6 months, along with monthly interest as this Court may deem reasonable.

Keeping in view the fact that the site was resumed on account of misuse of the building by the tenant and that tenant has since vacated building and that there is no misuse and the fact that the petitioner is a widow lady, she is permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to deposit the amount demanded by the Estate Officer, vide order dated 14.01.2000, along with the interest @ 10% per annum from the date of the order dated 14.01.2000 till the date of the deposit of the amount on or before 30.06.2015. On deposit of the amount so determined by the Estate Officer, the site-in-question shall stand restored to the petitioner.
