RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.' for short), seeks direction against respondents No.1 & 2 to take action on his representation dated 03.04.2012 Annexure P-4, as per law.

Notice of motion was issued. It is submitted by learned counsel for State that two FIRs have been registered. Investigation conducted. Report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction in FIR No.39 dated 12.06.2012.

Learned counsel for the State submits that challan has been prepared in the second FIR as well and the same will be presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction within a period of three weeks from today. She further submits that the abovesaid action having been taken on the

representation of the petitioner, present petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on the other hand, submits that the investigation conducted is not fair and proper. Petitioner is not satisfied with the investigation conducted. He prays for transferring the investigation to some senior officer.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties at considerable length, after careful perusal of the record of the case and giving thoughtful consideration to the contentions raised, this Court is of the considered opinion that whatever appropriate action was required, the same has been taken. If the petitioner is still not satisfied, he may avail remedy in accordance with law, however, present petition does not survive and the same is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
