Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seek quashing of FIR No.3 dated 03.01.2009 under Sections 420, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Old Gurgaon, District Gurgaon (Annexure P-7).

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the State submits that since the cancellation report has already been prepared in the present case and the same shall be presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction in the near future, present petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as such.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners also fairly states that let the present petition be disposed, in view of the statement

made by learned counsel for the State but the respondent-investigating agency may be directed to ensure filing of the cancellation report before the learned Court of competent jurisdiction without any further loss of time.

In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the parties, present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, Commissioner of Police, Gurgaon is directed to ensure that the cancellation report already prepared in the present case, is presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction without any further loss of time and in any case, within a period of four weeks from today.

Disposed of, accordingly.
