K.Kannan, J. (Oral)

The petitioner's case for refund of fee paid for her daughter for the second year in BPT Physiotherapy course of 1999 batch is that her daughter could not pursue the course on account of the fact that she was debarred from joining the second year for a period of 2 years, on account of her involvement in an UMC at the time of examination of the first year. The fee of ₹1,41,130/- for 2nd year was reported to have been paid by the petitioner in advance at the time of joining the college. I direct the amount of what has been paid by the petitioner for the second year for her daughter which she

did not pursue, to be paid by the 2nd respondent-College with interest at 7.5% from the date of filing of the writ petition till date of payment. The petitioner may engage the 2nd respondent in an appropriate communication and secure the amount within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

The writ petition is allowed on the above terms.
