Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated December 13, 2008 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya, whereby application under section 340 Cr.P.C. has been dismissed.

It appears that Ashok Kumar had filed a criminal complaint pursuant to which FIR No.95 dated 13.05.1985 was registered under Sections 353/332/506 IPC at Police Station Dasuya. After acquittal of the accused in the said case, he moved application under Section 340 Cr.P.C. alleging that he had been falsely implicated in the case at the instance of Joginder Singh, Executive Officer, Municipal Committee, Dasuya. As the petitioner failed to produce any documentary evidence to prove his assertion, his application was dismissed. He unsuccessfully challenged the order before the Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for petitioner has not been able to point out any

infirmity with the orders passed by the courts below. I find no ground to interfere in the inherent jurisdiction of this court.

Dismissed.
