This is an appeal against the judgment of acquittal dated 1.11.2013 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur whereby the respondents No.2 to 6 were acquitted under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC.

During the pendency of the present appeal, the appellant has since died. Learned counsel for the appellant has moved an application for impleadment of the LRs of the appellant. However, the registry took some objections and the same could not be listed. On the last date of hearing vide order dated 2.12.2015, the parties were directed to appear before this Court.

In pursuance to the order, the daughter of the

appellant has appeared before this Court and states that she has

solemnized marriage with respondent No.2. She is staying at her matrimonial home and a child is born out of the wedlock. She states that she is looked after well by her in-laws family.

In view of the statement of daughter of the appellant, the wife of the appellant Mrs. Karamjit Kaur states that she does not want to pursue the present appeal.

In view of above, the present appeal is dismissed.
