Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to transfer the investigation of the case FIR No.683 dated 1.11.2012 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 506 IPC registered at Police Station City Jind to the State Crime Branch.

Learned State counsel has placed on record a communication dated 24.11.2015 issued by the Superintendent of Police/Law & Order, office of the Director General of Police, Haryana. The contents of letter read as under:

“It has been decided to transfer the investigation case FIR No.683 dated 01.11.2012 u/s 406/420 IPC P City Jind, Distt. Jind to State Crime Branch, Haryana.

You are requested to take over the case file of the case and to conduct further investigation. A copy of complaint received from Shri Vikram Mor r/o Narwana Road, Jind is sent herewith.”

The above communication clearly shows that the authority has decided to transfer the investigation of the FIR to the State Crime Branch, Haryana.

In view of the aforesaid communication, no further direction is required to be issued and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
