Having argued for some time, when this Court was not inclined to entertain the instant second revision petition (which is otherwise legally barred under Section 397(3) Cr.P.C.) in the garb of petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., in the matter of interim maintenance awarded by the Courts below, in the wake of main petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C., instituted by claimant Deepinder Kaur minor, against her mother Navinderjit Kaur (petitioner), then the learned counsel intends to withdraw the present petition to enable the petitioner to take/urge all the points contained in it, at the appropriate stage of trial of main maintenance petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty, as prayed for.

Needless to mention that the trial Court would naturally decide the main petition on the basis of evidence brought on record by the parties and in accordance with law.
