AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 26.03.2012 whereby non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner.

On 14.09.2015 the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been settled and the petitioner has issued a post dated cheque to the complainant-respondent and if the matter is adjourned for two months that payment would also have been cleared.

Learned counsel for the respondent-complainant states that he has no objection to wait for two months.

Adjourned to 03.12.2015.”

Today the learned counsel for the respondent has accepted that the entire payment has been received and he will withdraw the complaint on the next date.

In the circumstances, the impugned order is set aside and the non-bailable warrants issued against the petitioner are quashed.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
