Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that since the similar controversy has been set at rest by this Court vide order dated 26.11.2010 passed in CWP No. 5993 of 1990 (Deva Singh v. The State of Haryana and others), which has been upheld by the LPA Bench vide its order dated 2.8.2011 passed in LPA No. 1311 of 2011 (Haryana Financial Corporation, Chandigarh v. Deva Singh and others), let the present writ petition be disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in Deva Singh's case (supra).

Ordered accordingly.

In view of the above, respondent No.2 is directed to do the needful at an early date but in any case within a period of three months from today. If needful is not done within the stipulated period, the petitioners shall be entitled for interest @ 9% per annum from the date the amount became due till the date of actual payment.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present writ petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
