This order shall dispose of the aforementioned three petitions as the same have been arisen out of the FIR No.8 dated 12.11.2010 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Sections 7, 13(1)(D) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Phase-I, Punjab at Mohali, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Veerpal Kaur, State Vigilance Bureau, Phase-I, Mohali, submits that in the case in hand, the trial has concluded and vide judgment dated 27.7.2015 passed by learned Special Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali, the petitioner has been convicted for the offence punishable under Sections 120-B IPC and Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 with the aid of Section 120-B IPC.

The copy of aforementioned judgment produced on record by learned counsel for the State, is taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid development, the present petition does not survive and is rendered infructuous.
