Mohammad Iftikahar Alam Vs. Commissioner & ors.

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This appeal is under Workmen's Compensation Act. Along with the appeal, application for condonation of delay was also filed. The private respondents No.1 and 2 were not being served for want of complete address and the appellant was directed by the Hon'ble High Court to take dasti summons for their service. The file of the appeal indicates that without service of the respondents and without any order of condoning the delay, appeal was admitted on 10th July, 2006.

Now, appeal has been received by the Lok Adalat. Again, respondents could not be served on the addresses given. No effective order, at this stage, can be passed by the Lok Adalat in the absence of the respondents.

Since appeal is of the year 2002, it is ordered to be consigned to the record room with liberty to the appellant to get it revived, if so advised, after getting particulars of the respondents for their service.
