The prayer made in the instant petition is for quashing of orders dated 08.10.2013 (Annexure P-7) passed by Addl. District Judge, Hoshiarpur and 24.5.2010 (Annexure P-6) passed by SDJM, Garhshankar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the instant petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the contentions at appropriate stage before the trial Court.

The instant petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty with a direction to the petitioner to deposit outstanding arrears

within one month before the trial Court by way of bank draft in the name of respondent No.1 after adjusting the amount already paid, which shall be disbursed to respondent No.1 by the trial Court on obtaining surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 on the other hand submits that respondent No.1 is present in person and denies that any amount has been paid out of the arrears, which is for the learned Magistrate to look into.
