Respondent No.3, who happens to be the son of respondent No.2 has stated that respondent No.2 Harbhajan Singh, his father, has died in the year 2007. This fact has also not been disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner, as stated to him by HC Sukhdev Singh, Police Station Machhiwara after verification from the Sarpanch Kulwinder Singh village Kotala Bet.
